
On behalf of the MSP Redevelopment Commission, it is my pleasure to thank you for your interest in the MSP Redevelopment Project Site and the potential it holds as a location for the museum facilities that your organization intends to develop in the Jefferson City area.

With this letter, they wish to convey their earnest desire and intent to continue discussions with your organization, the Missouri Naval Museum, for the purpose of accommodating your proposal to locate a museum on a parcel of the property at the MSP Redevelopment Site.

It is their understanding that you have performed preliminary evaluations of the MSP Redevelopment Master-plan documents focusing on a portion of the site that fronts on the Missouri River and that you have determined that the site appears to be suitable for your intended purpose of developing a museum and docking facility for several ships that you plan to acquire and relocate to the site.

They have reviewed your preliminary proposal and find general agreement with your concepts and stated objectives for the development of a Missouri Naval Museum facility at the MSP Redevelopment Site.

Therefore, they have authorized this letter to indicate their intent to commit and allocate a portion of the MSP Redevelopment Site for the purpose of a Missouri Naval Museum Facility, subject to further negotiation and final agreement to additional terms and conditions relating to the development of such a facility.
